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## Our Unique & Best Practices

	Practices	Description
1	TNA (Training Need Analysis)	Each admitted child is assessed and advised on the required training. This makes it easier <b>to identify their strengths and weaknesses early</b> on and move towards appropriate solutions.
2	SPS (Student Profile System)	A file is opened for each child taking admission. Apart from the child's personal details, <b>the child's health records and monthly or weekly reports</b> are also attached to this file.
2	IEP (Individual Education Program)	Students who need extra help and support in school may be eligible for special education services in the form of an individualized education program (IEP). This program is offered at a normal fee to the students. <b>It helps a lot in bringing up children who are backward in learning.</b>
3	FEP (Family Empowerment Programs)	We offer monthly parenting sessions according to the age and stage of the child's development, to help the parents develop proper parenting skills so that they can keep a positive relationship with their children and raise them as academically successful, responsible and disciplined personalities. Apart from this, parents are getting training in <b>physical health education, mental health education, success education and wealth education</b> through these classes. Every parent who attends regularly can gain more knowledge on their respective subjects and thereby make changes in themselves, their child and their family. As most of these sessions are attended by mothers, training is also provided on healthy food cooking techniques. A family festival is held for boosting up the <b>happy hormones</b> . It causes mental euphoria from the stressful life environment.
4	SNT (Social & Nature study Travels)	Nature walk provides the children interaction with nature, and live learning experience to make discoveries, raise doubts and solve problems. <b>It reduces stress and anxiety, and develops self-expression, creativity and socialization skills.</b> Exposure to sunlight makes the children physically and emotionally fit. Such trips are useful to reach out to the helpless people of the society, understand their difficulties and <b>develop sympathy, empathy and kindness</b> towards them.
5	SEP (Staff Empowerment Programs)	We have trained faculties <b>to take classes on our concepts of education</b> and teacher-student-parent relationship to our staff regularly to motivate and help them in understanding responsibilities, accomplishing duties and keeping a good relationship with all the children and parents alike
6	Student's counseling	We provide counseling for children in their educational and personal issues and give them moral support. We give special attention <b>to each child's behaviors, habits and management of negative emotions, and relieve the child</b> from depression, anxiety, stress and other mental health issues.
7	HEP (Health Education Program)	Health education programs <b>provide age appropriate information about health and nutrition to the children in schools.</b> It helps to promote healthy behaviors among the children that they will inculcate for life. It is to detect and maintain BMI. This program promotes safe menstrual hygiene practices by girls. We teach karate/yoga/meditation as a part of health education. Health checkups are done on children, problems are diagnosed and solutions are provided through classes for children and parents.

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
